**MECHANISM AND FORMATION OF THE CONCERN CELL**

In view of the GCC Regulations, 2015 in regard to prevention, prohibition and Redressal of Sexual Harassment of Women Employees and Students in Higher educational Institutions, Gauhati Commerce College, Guwahati-21 seeks to form an accountable Cell for the execution of and strong adherence to the recommended provisions in order to ensure adequate gender sensitivity at our workplace. The primary objectives of the Cell have provisionally been decided upon:

- a) **Dealing with the complaints relating to sexual harassment in the institutions and working upon the redressal of such complaints.**
- b) **Spreading awareness about gender-related issues in the light of contemporary socio-psychological vicissitudes.**
- c) **Improving a harassment-free ambience inside and outside the campus.**

Since the college has a zero-tolerance policy towards sexual harassment, any aggrieved employee or student can directly and courageously approach the President or any member of the Committee for any sort of complaint or may also drop an application in white paper to drop in the box kept separately for the purpose. The complaint, in whatever format, will be kept confidential.
